

By creating PDF-Microfiche interoperability, the DigitalFilmFirchive system supports the archiving, the legal requirements and the securitu of the dematerialized documents while fully integrating the codes of the digital economy

Durability / Reliability

- **→ Durability**: Silver microfiches have a longevity of more than 300 years, by their properties alone.
- + Guarantee of operability: However far we go in the future, we will always be able to access the content of the images of a microfiche, unlike electronic media which are plagued by hardware and software obsolescence.
- → Guaranteed intelligibility: On microfiche, digital archives are recorded in clear, which protects them from the obsolescence of computer languages and means of transcoding.

Efficiency / Simplicity

Developed in France in 2010, the

DigitalFilmArchive system simplifies the management of dematerialized archives.

Because the cloning of the PDF on microfiche has the effect of producing the same archives in two joint forms, insuring at the same time:

- + the fluidity of the PDF for technical functions and the short term:
- → the irreversibility and durability of microfiches for critical functions and long term.

Integrity / Legal value

By necessity, the microfiche production process cannot lead to any other result than the integral and permanent irreversibility of the medium.

For this reason, any modification of the information recorded on microfiche is impossible.

This guarantee of integrity of dematerialized archives is essential:

- → at the archival level, to attest to an intact
- → at the legal level, to produce compliant and reliable means of proof.

Cybersecurity / Privacy

The DigitalFilmArchive system ensures the security of essential digital archives:

- their recording on microfiches places the dematerialized archives beyond the reach of cybercrime, such as hacking, ransoming, usurpation...
- → this solution thus makes it possible to safeguard archives containing secret, confidential or sensitive information, from the shortest to the longest term.
